

Normally Sacrifice if temple existed

Daniel 9:20-27 (NKJV)

Now while I was speaking, praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the Lord my God for the holy mountain of my God, 21 yes, while I was speaking in prayer, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, reached me about the time of the evening offering.

angel was complete?

70 weeks - Prophecy = 490 years

day for a year Ezek 4:6 Num 14:34

decided, settled - could not take longer

seal up or be done with. Matt 5:17?

baptize Christ? Most Holy Always pointed to temple

anoint temple in heaven?

This is when the 490 years start. must finish

490 years later - it was determined

Yeshua is the messiah & peace

483 years + 7 weeks = 490

62 weeks = 434

After 483 years (ADD 7 weeks) = 490 AD

Prince who? Messiah

destroyed by Rome 70 AD

Christ did not die for himself

He died for us

decided & staunch

Brings to ruin

makes what desolate? Temple Based on sacrifice

greatly disliked or abhorred

complete - fulfilled

Prayer

22 And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, "O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand. 23 At the beginning of your supplications the command went out, and I have come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision:

24 "Seventy weeks are determined

For your people and for your holy city,

To finish the transgression,

To make an end of sins,

To make reconciliation for iniquity,

To bring in everlasting righteousness,

To seal up vision and prophecy,

And to anoint the Most Holy

25 "Know therefore and understand,

That from the going forth of the command

To restore and build Jerusalem

Until Messiah the Prince,

There shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks;

The street shall be built again, and the wall,

Even in troublesome times.

26 "And after the sixty-two weeks

Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself;

And the people of the prince who is to come

shall destroy the city and the sanctuary.

The end of it shall be with a flood,

And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one

week;

But in the middle of the week

he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering.

And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes

desolate,

Even until the consummation, which is determined,

is poured out on the desolate."

1. This prophecy is @ the end of the 70 week prophecy that started in 457 BC

This brings the end to 34 AD. 31 AD would be sacrifice end - Christ died

34 AD Stephen died & Gospel spread past Jews

This would mean the abomination is Christ (15 49:7; 53:A) & he made the temple desolate.

This being true - Christ would be the prince in v 26b; but how?
